Innovation, education and collaboration

The project has collaborated with industry, suppliers and subcontractors to innovate, educate and promote positive environmental outcomes through onsite trials and case studies. The team has also developed and lead workshops, field days, education sessions and tour groups to promote and share the successes and lessons learnt during the projects operations.

The project team involved Certified Professional in Erosion and Sediment Control (CPESC) staff at all levels including Client, Joint Venture staff, independent verifiers and independent auditors. During the construction the project hosted over 200 weekly, 45 monthly and 16 quarterly independent audits from separate companies and verifiers including local regulator inspections specifically related to ESC. Strong IECA Industry member involvement, documented trials, site innovations, educational presentations and tertiary body collaborations contributed to the success of the project.

The team has continually demonstrated a sustainability focussed, collaborative and proactive approach to managing erosion and sediment control risks. During the project time the proactive subcontractor and supplier engagement has fostered an innovative culture. Key has been communication and collaborative where the initiatives have included research, development trials and knowledge sharing to a range of stakeholders, resulting in excellent environmental outcomes.
